Note 7 Students may take 3 hours of Social and Behavioral sciences from: ANTH 2351; ECON 2301, 2302; GEOG 1303, 1302; PSYC 2301, PSY 153; SOCI 1301, SOC 139.

Note 8 Three additional hours from: ENGL 2322,2323,2332,2333 or 2000-level Literature.
