Note 6 Three hours of Texas history can be substituted in satisfying this requirement.

Note 7 3 hours of Social & Behavioral Science must be taken from: GEOG 1303 (**All-level may take any course from the Core**).

Note 8 3 additional hours from MATH 1314 or advisor approved Math.

Note 9 TECA 1318 and 1354 will sub for KIN 332 and EPS 380.
