Note 2 The remaining 3-4 hours can be selected from the following: BUSI 2304; ENGL 2311; FREN 1411,1412; SPAN 1411, 1412; beginning foreign language; SPH 172, 272 unless Core is Complete, then elective may be taken.

Note 3 MATH 1314, 1324, 1342 or advisor approved math can be substituted for 129.

Note 4 **Students must take two different lab science courses from XXX Core or: recommend CHE/ PHY 125, CHEM or PHYS from XXX Core and BIOL 1408**

Note 5 3 hours of visual/performing arts course from XXX Core however **ARTS 1301 strongly recommended**.

Note 6 3 hours humanities from XXX core or: ENGL 2322,2323,2332,2333 or 2000-level Lit.

Note 7 Three hours of History or Texas history from XXX Core can be substituted in satisfying this requirement.

Note 9 HIST 2301 will substitute for HIS 335; and ECON 2301 will sub for HMS 445 for Generalist and Social Studies.

Note 10 EDUC 1301 and 2301 will substitute for the advanced level courses listed.
