Note 6 Three hours of Texas history can be substituted in satisfying this requirement.

Note 7 Students may take 3 hours of Social and Behavioral sciences from: ANT 231; ECON 2301, 2302; GEOG 1303, GEO 230; PSYC 2301, 2306; SOCI 1301, 2319.

Note 8 Three additional hours from: ENGL 2332,2333,2322,2323 or 2000-level Lit.
