Note 2 6 hours of mathematics can be chosen from: MTH 110,MATH 1316,1314,1348,1324,1325,1442, 2413, 2414, (MATH 1442 recommended).

Note 3 Students must take 8 hours of natural science from the following: BIO 225,BIOL 1411,1413, 2401; CHEM 1411,1412,CHE 231; ENV 110; GEOL 1403,1404; PHY 110,PHYS 1401,1402; AST 105; (BIOL 2401 and CHEM 1411 recommended).

Note 4 Students must take a visual/performing arts course from: ARTS 1301, 1303, 1304; MUSI 1306,1300; DRAM 1310; DANC 2303.

Note 5 Students must take a humanities course from: ENGL 2332, 2333, 2322, 2323; PHIL 1301,2306; HIST 2311, 2312.

Note 6 Three hours of Texas history can be substituted in satisfying this requirement.

Note 7 Students may take 3 hours of Social and Behavioral sciences from: ANT 231; ECON 2301, 2302; GEOG 1303, GEO 230; PSYC 2301, 2306; SOCI 1301, SOC 139.

Note 8 Select 8 hours from a single natural lab science from: [BIO 225,BIOL 1411,1413, 2401]; [CHEM 1411, 1412, CHE 231]; [ENV 110; GEOL 1403, 1404]; [PHY 110, PHYS 1401,1402; AST 105].

Note 9 6-8 hours can be selected from sciences in Note 8; MATH 1314 or higher; BCIS 1305, approved COSC course; modern foreign language; PHIL 2303; or from Sophomore Literature.
