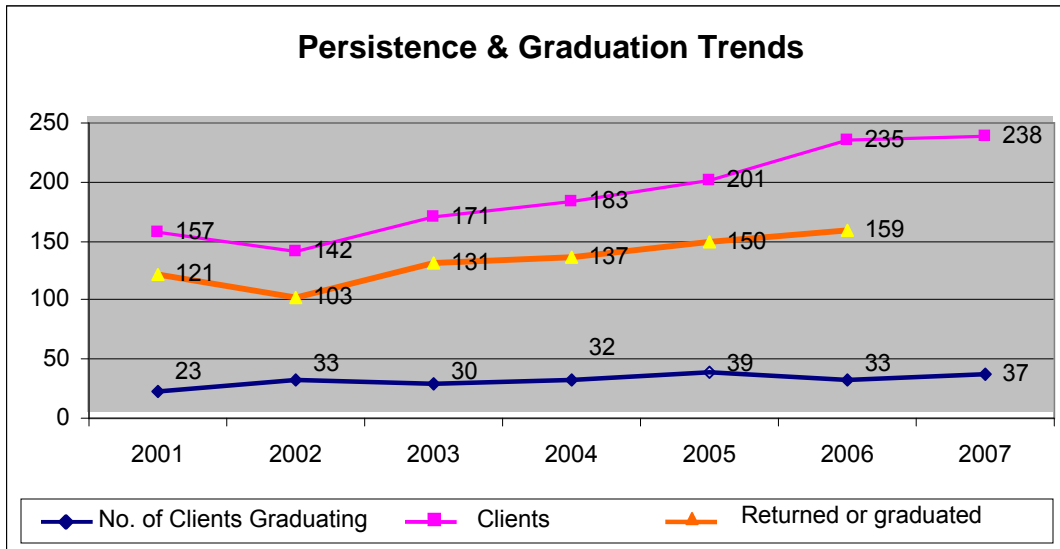


4-year Trends in Disability Services
