# Deans Council May 28, 2014

#### 1. Alumni Association/Academic Colleges

Craig Turnage Craig Turnage is the new Executive Director for Alumni Relations, he met with the deans to explain their goals and to ask if there is anything they can do to help the deans. He stated they are developing alumni networks and their goal is to have alumni reengaged. A new website for the department will be launched within the next few weeks. He mentioned a couple of initiatives we already have, such as the Big Dip, Distinguished Professor Award. He would like to be as open and helpful as possible. He encouraged the deans to contact him if there was anything he could do.

### 2. Emergency Operations

Dr. Berry reported that a mock active shooting emergency drill took place on campus recently, it went very well. Dr. Berry said we need to update our emergency building contact list and asked the deans to send updated information to Sharon. ## 3. Faculty Workload Policy

Enrollment update, Dr. Berry stated although it is early, housing is currently down by 6%, enrollment is 100 ahead of this time last year.
