

TSI for Orientation Attendees

SUBMITTING SCORES

You are required to submit all TSI exemption and/or TSI Assessment scores to the Student Success Center *before* registering for classes. You may submit TSI documentation by email; be sure to write your SFA ID number on the documentation. Your registration clearance cannot be processed until the required information is received. Turn in your information as soon as possible. It is okay if your TSI scores are not passing, send in what you have, even if you plan on retesting.

SUBMITTING COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT(S)

If you have already taken any college-level coursework, you must submit college transcript(s) showing grades earned for review. For faster updating of your TSI status, send a copy of your transcript to tsi@sfasu.edu. You must turn in TSI scores for any subject area of math, reading, and writing in which you are not considered “College Ready.”

TESTING

- ▶ Check your former high school or local college for testing availability in your area.
- ▶ SFA offers on-site testing. Call 936-468-3958 to schedule a testing session.
- ▶ Online Testing - go to www.sfasu.edu/tsi and click on COVID-19 and TSI Testing link located on the left of the screen to find out information about taking the TSI Assessment online.

CHECK YOUR TSI STATUS

If your SFA student TSI record indicates that you have “No TSI Status on file,” this means that SFA does not have scores that meet the minimum exemption standards and you have not turned in TSI Assessment scores. Call the Student Success Center to speak with a TSI advisor.

You may view your TSI Status and what testing scores SFA has on file for you by logging on to your mySFA account. At the top of the page click on the Advising tab. Under the College Readiness section, click on “View TSI Status” link.
