Note 1 Students must take 3 hrs from either SPCH 1315 or BUSI 2304 (SPCH 1315 recommended).

Note 2 The remaining 3-4 hours can be selected from the following: ENGL 2311; FREN 1411,1412; SPAN 1411,1412; SGNL 1301/1401 or 1302/1402; or beginning foreign language . Note 2 not required if Core is Complete.

Note 4 Students must take three different lab science courses from the XXX Core or advisor approved SFA adv level Science.

Note 5 Students must take a visual/performing arts course from the XXX Core or: ARTS 1301, DRAM 1310 or DANC 2303.

Note 6 Students must take 3 hrs from a humanities course from the XXX Core or: ENGL 2322,2323,2332,2333.

Note 7 Must take either GOVT 2301 & 2302 or GOVT 2305 & 2306 to meet Legislative requirement.

Note 8 EDUC 1301 will sub for HMS 241/L; EDUC 2301 will sub for EPS 380.

Note 9 3 hrs from MATH 1314,1324,1342 will sub for MTH 129.
