Note 5 Students must take a visual/performing arts course from the XXX Core or: ARTS 1301, DRAM 1310 or DANC 2303.

Note 6 Students must take a humanities course from the XXX Core or: ENGL 2322,2323,2332,2333 or 2000-level Lit.

Note 7 Three hours of History or Texas history from XXX Core can be substituted. GOVT 2305 & 2306 can sub for 2301/2302.

Note 8 EDUC 1301 will sub for HMS 241/L; EDUC 2301 will sub for EPS 380.

Note 9 MATH 1314,1324,1342 or an advisor approved Math will sub for MTH 129.
