School Psychology candidates take PRAXIS II 0400. The Texas State Board of Examiners of Psychologist also requires a Jurisprudence Examination for all candidates for licensure. Scores on the PRAXIS II range from 250 to 990 with median score at 700. School Psychology has a 100% pass rate across all years. Scores range from a 660 to 800. For our program completers, the PRAXIS II yearly means for all program completers are as follows:

2002: N of 4 Mean = 677.5 (range 660 to 700)

2003: N of 3 Mean = 703.33 (range 670 to 720)

2004: N of 1 Score = 700 (only score = 700)

2005: No test takers

The TExES Content Test for Educational Leadership centers on three domains: (1) School and Community Leadership, (2) Instructional Leadership, and (3) Administrative Leadership. The scores for candidates in the Educational Leadership Program show candidates have the necessary content knowledge for success in schools with scores of over 96% passing.

The TExES Content Test for School Guidance and Counseling centers on three domains: (1) Understanding Students, (2) Planning and Implementing Developmental Guidance and Counseling Program, and (3) Collaboration, Consultation, and Professionalism. The scores reveal that 100% of the candidates for school counselor passed their certification exams.

The TExES Content Test for Educational Diagnostician addresses four domains: (1) Students with Disabilities, (2) Assessment and Evaluation, (3) Curriculum and Instruction, and (4) Foundations and Professional Roles and Responsibilities. The results indicate that the candidates in the program score above the state and national average with a passing rate of 100%.
