

Unit Assessment Oversight Committee

The purpose of the Unit Assessment Oversight Committee is to ensure that the unit and program assessments are operational and to oversee the review of the data and the assessment system.

1. Committee Composition
 - 2 members from each department representing initial and advanced programs
 - 1 or more representatives from other colleges
 - Representative from the Office of Assessment and Accountability
 - Data management director
 - Karen Hall or other Institutional Research representative
2. Committee Responsibilities
 - Provide faculty oversight of the Unit assessment System
 - Review/monitor unit and program assessment reports
 - Review/recommend assessment policies
 - Review aggregated unit assessment data to make recommendations regarding the unit assessment systems and individual assessments
 - Make recommendations to University Core Curriculum as data indicates
 - Review the Unit Assessment System and make recommendations for revision as appropriate
 - Report results of reviews to the Dean and the Teacher Education Council

3. Reporting Structure

Unit Assessment Oversight Committee (UAOC) is a standing College of Education committee. Faculty representatives are appointed for 2-year terms and serve on a rotation basis so that there are always members with experience on the committee.

UAOC reports to the Associate Dean of the College.

UAOC work is supported and facilitated by the Office of Assessment & Accountability.

Annual Program and/or Departmental Reports are sent to the UAOC for review.
Annual Field Experience Reports from the Educator Certification office are sent to the UAOC for review.

Certification Exam updates from the Office of Assessment and Accountability are sent to the UAOC for review.
