The Overlap Program permits qualified undergraduates to pursue a *limited* amount of graduate study concurrently with undergraduate study. A maximum of 12 credit hours is allowed for those programs that require a minimum of 24 credit hours of course work. Those degree programs with higher credit hours of course work may allow more credit hours in the overlap program. Graduate courses taken in the program, however, are not applicable toward the baccalaureate degree.

To be eligible for the Overlap Program, a student must be enrolled at SFASU and must have achieved at least ninety-five (95) earned hours of undergraduate credit with a 2.5 GPA overall and a 2.8 GPA in the major field. A student with fewer than one hundred fifteen (115) undergraduate earned hours must present a 3.0 GPA both overall and in the major field.

When registering for courses, make sure they are 500 level courses.

Any student admitted to the Overlap Program must take the GRE at the earliest possible date.

ROUTING INSTRUCTIONS

1. The student will submit the completed form for approval from the Elementary Education Department Chair.
2. The approved form will be forwarded from the Department to the College of Education Dean for approval.
3. When this form has been approved and all signatures obtained, the Dean's Office will forward it to the Graduate Office (Liberal Arts North 423).
4. It is the responsibility of the student to follow up on the request and apply for admission to the Graduate School.
