

FINANCIAL AID TERMS/CONDITIONS AND AUTHORIZATIONS

- I understand this award is contingent upon the application and enrollment information supplied to the office from the FAFSA. Any change in enrollment, Admissions matriculation, residential and/or residency status must be reported and may affect your eligibility.
- I understand that I must maintain minimum course load requirements. Failure to do so may result in overpayment of aid received. Changes in enrollment for a given term may result in the reduction or cancellation of your award. In order to receive funds at the time of disbursement you must be enrolled at least half-time or 6 hours for both undergraduates and graduates.
- I understand that any outside resources such as scholarships, stipends, service awards or any other payment received from an outside agency may affect my financial aid award. I am responsible for notifying the Financial Aid Office if I receive funds before **or after** receiving financial aid so that adjustments can be made to **eliminate possible over awards**.
- I understand that federal regulations do not allow a student to receive federal financial aid at two universities during the same semester.
- I understand the awards are conditional pending meeting of Satisfactory Academic progress (SAP) requirements and that the Financial Aid Office reserves the right to review and cancel awards for failure to meet SAP criteria.
- I understand that by accepting this aid, I authorize any funds received must first be used to meet obligations to the University, including, but not limited to, tuition and fees, on-campus room and board, books and supplies or institutional short-term loans. Funds remaining after these expenses are paid may be used for other educational expenses.

In order to qualify for a Texas Grant all students must submit a Statement of Eligibility. I understand that if I fail to provide accurate information, I may be required to reimburse the institution and penalties may be imposed.

I understand that by answering “no” to the following question I will be in compliance with the Texas Grant Statement of Student Eligibility: “Have I ever been convicted of a felony or an offense under Chapter 481, Health & Safety Code (Texas Controlled Substances Act), or under the law of another jurisdiction involving a controlled substance as defined by Chapter 481, Health & Safety Code?”
