

CDFL Department Meeting 2/10/15

1. The revised summer schedule given to faculty members.
2. The Advisory board meeting proposed for 4/21/15. The faculty discussed possible ideas to discuss at board meeting including recruitment opportunities, scholarship opportunities, and how are our students doing in internships. It was reported that usually 7-8 members attend the board meeting.
3. Faculty were educated on the difference between category 2 and 3 related to intellectual property and online courses. Category 2 is owned by the faculty and the university. Category 3 is owned only by the university. Dr. Martin would like any courses being offered online as a go through the steps to make them official through OIT as a category 3. Courses should be ready by Spring 2016 which means they need to be approved by OIT October 2015. The courses CDFL is focusing on at this time is 242, 201, 551, and 586.
4. CDFL faculty have been asked to develop a letter for students who are interested in the program for recruitment purposes.
5. Dr. Mize indicated that all areas of CDFL website has been updated. She will talk to Dr. Martin about who manages the website.
6. Dr. Lumar reported JCFR is doing several things to promote Family Life Education month including producing buttons to hand out, putting factoids about families on the marquee, and working with Head Start. JCFR will also focus on week of young child, child abuse prevention and military families in April. Students will present education on parenting to Azleway in April.
7. CDFL will host a book drive to help Head Start.
