## Speech-Language Pathology Leveling Sequence

❖ **Leveling students are admitted one-time a year and must be advised by the program office before beginning the leveling sequence.**

Students who have graduated with a bachelor’s degree in other fields of study are required to complete 12 undergraduate communication sciences and disorders courses (36 credit hours) before being accepted into the graduate program, successful completion of the leveling program **\*does not guarantee admission into the graduate program**. In addition, there are four non-SPH courses that must appear on your transcript, these courses include: Biological Science (Concepts of Biology, A&P, Human Biology, etc.), Physical Science (Physics or Chemistry – introductory or basic are acceptable), Social or Behavioral Science (Psychology, Sociology or Anthropology), and Statistics.

**The admission requirements for leveling students are:**

1. Have obtained a bachelor’s degree
2. Admitted to Stephen F. Austin State University
3. Minimum overall GPA of 2.75 in all college work
4. Completion of a minimum of three courses with a minimum grade of a B
