- Note 5: **All BA degrees require foreign language proficiency through SFA level 232 (2312) of the same language which includes courses numbered as 1411 (131), 1412 (132), 2311 (231), and 2312 (232).**
- Note 6: Three hours from LSC Social & Behavioral Science Core
- Note 7: **Both GOVT 2305 and 2306 should be taken at LSC to satisfy Government/Political Science Legislative & Core requirement.**
- Note 8: Six hours from LSC History Core

A maximum of 66 hours of academic courses plus up to 4 hours of PHED/KINE courses from community colleges can be applied in a bachelor's degree
