- Note 6: **Both GOVT 2305 and 2306 should be taken at LSC to satisfy Government/Political Science Legislative & Core requirement.**
- Note 7: Six hours from LSC History Core from: HIST 1301 (HIS 133), HIST 1302 (HIS 134) or HIST 2301(HIS 2--)
- Note 8: **BS degree requires six to eight additional hours from one of the following sequences:** ANT 248(ANTH 2401), ANT 251, GEO 130(GEOG 1301); BIO 131(BIOL 1411), BIO 133 (BIOL 1413), BIO 225, 238 (BIOL 2401), 239 (BIOL 2402); CHE 133(CHEM 1411),134(CHEM 1412), 231; ENV 110 (ENVR 1401), GOL 131 (GEOL 1403), 132 (GEOL 1404); AST 105, PHY 110, PHY 131 (PHYS 1401), 132 (PHYS 1402), 241(PHYS 2425), 242(PHYS 2426). - Note 9: ENGL 2311(ENG 273) is required for BS degree.
