- Be willing to move to locations in the Southeast
- Be interested in working in and fostering an inclusive work environment

Participants will gain:

- Paid Experience - A paid 24 week internship
- Hiring Certificate - A hiring authority allowing interns to apply to internal Forest Service positions.
- Mentorship - Work alongside a master performer throughout the program in an apprentice-style setting
- Opportunity - At the end of the program, interns will be invited to a Southern Region job fair to apply for full-time positions similar to those they trained for during the internship
