Delivery shall be made during normal working hours only, unless prior approval for early or late delivery has been obtained.

If delay is foreseen, contractor shall give written notice. The University has the right to extend delivery date if reasons appear valid. Default in promised delivery (without accepted reasons) or failure to meet specifications, authorizes the University to purchase supplies elsewhere and charge full increase, if any, in cost and handling to defaulting contractor.

No substitutions or cancellations are permitted

without prior written approval.

ALTERNATE DISPUTE RESOLUTION:

Pursuant to Chapter 2260 of the Texas Government Code, any dispute arising under a contract for goods and services for which this chapter applies must be resolved under the provisions of this chapter.

Information, documentation, and other material in connection with this solicitation or any resulting contract may be subject to public disclosure pursuant to Chapter 552 of the Texas Government Code (the "Public Information Act").
