What Army ROTC Scholarships offers you:

2, 3 and 4-year scholarships available

- If you are awarded a four year scholarship to SFA Army ROTC, the cadet may also be provided the following:

- **Dorm Scholarship:** All Freshmen - Living & Learning community program worth \$1,600 a semester
- **Nurse Scholarship:** Ask about our incentives for the Army Nursing Program

THE TOTAL SCHOLARSHIP EQUALS \$80,000.00

Minimum qualifications for a 4-year Army ROTC scholarship:

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be between the ages of 17 and 26
- Have a high school GPA of at least 2.50
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Score minimum of 920 on the SAT (math/verbal) or 19 on the ACT (excluding the required writing test scores)
- Meet physical standards
- Agree to accept a commission and serve in the Army on Active Duty or in a Reserve Component (U.S. Army Reserve or Army National Guard)
