



2009 Fact Sheet for Army ROTC Simultaneous Membership Program (SMP) at Stephen F. Austin



What SMP Is:

Available for both National Guard and U. S. Army Reserve enlisted soldiers.

Allows you to participate in your local reserve component unit while completing your college education.

What Army ROTC SMP offers you:

- Normal drill pay at your current rank until you contract as a cadet
- Pay at E-5 level once you contract \$260
- MGIB (Tax Free) \$329
- SMP Kicker \$350
- ROTC Stipend \$300-500

GRFD – Guaranteed Reserve Forces Duty Scholarship

You will serve your military obligation with the Reserve Components (either National Guard or the U.S. Army Reserve)

- \$1200 for books per year (\$600 per semester)

Minimum qualifications for a 4-year Army ROTC

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be between the ages of 17 and 26
- Have a high school GPA of at least 2.50
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Score minimum of 920 on the SAT (math/verbal) or 19 on the ACT (excluding the required writing test scores)
- Meet physical standards
- Agree to accept a commission and serve in the Army on Active Duty or in a Reserve Component (U.S. Army Reserve or Army National Guard)
