Nominating

Each chapter may nominate themselves and/or other chapters for any of the chapter awards listed below. For the individual awards, you can nominate yourself or another member within your chapter. The nomination should be completed through the appropriate forms that have been made available to you in this document, through email and on the Order of Omega website.

Awards Selection

A selections committee will be comprised of Order of Omega members, Greek Life and Student Engagement Staff. Applications will be viewed in an anonymous form by whiting out names and assigning numbers. An individual that is outside from the committee will have documentation of these number assignments.

Award Criteria

Individual Awards

Greek Man of the Year

- *Awarded to: IFC, MGC or NPHC men*
- Must be a graduating Senior
- Must be in good standing with organization and University
- Must be an active member in their chapter for a minimum of one academic year (2 long semesters)
- Must be active in community service
- Has made a significant contribution to the Greek community
- Holds leadership positions on campus with organizations or committees
- Must hold a leadership role in their chapter
- Must possess high academic record
- Promotes Greek Unity
- *Max. of 2 nominations per chapter*

Greek Woman of the Year

- *Awarded to: PHC, MGC or NPHC women*
- Must be a graduating Senior
- Must be in good standing with organization and University
- Must be an active member in their chapter for a minimum of one academic year (2 long semesters)
- Must be active in community service
- Has made a significant contribution to the Greek community
- Holds leadership positions on campus with organizations or committees
- Must hold a leadership role in their chapter
- Must possess high academic record
- Promotes Greek Unity
- *Max. of 2 nominations per chapter*



Outstanding Chapter President

- *Awarded to: One chapter per council*
- Must have served as President for one full term, as determined by chapter
- Must be in good standing with university and their organization
- Must be active in community service/ university involvement
- Has exhibited outstanding leadership
- Has made a significant contribution to the Greek community
- *Nominations made by Greek Life Staff*

Outstanding Chapter Advisor

- *Awarded to: One faculty/staff or alumni advisor*
- Organization advised must be registered with the Office of Student Engagement
- Must actively advise the organization and have been volunteer advisor for at least one year
- Must have been available to the members of the organization, open to new ideas and valued student input
- Must have shown dedication to and interest in the organization
- Adviser role must be voluntary, not a part of a job description
- *Each chapter is able to nominate their advisor once*

Chapter Awards

Overall Outstanding Fraternity

- This award is given to honor the fraternity chapter that encompasses all of what Greek organizations stand for in the Greek community and Stephen F. Austin State University. This chapter excels in scholarship, upholds their standards and ideals, provides service to SFA and the Nacogdoches community, goes above and beyond in chapter collaborations, and upholds the five root principles of the SFA Way.
- *Each chapter is able to nominate themselves once*

Overall Outstanding Sorority

- This award is given to honor the sorority chapter that encompasses all of what Greek organizations stand for in the Greek community and Stephen F. Austin State University. This chapter excels in scholarship, upholds their standards and ideals, provides service to SFA and the Nacogdoches community, goes above and beyond in chapter collaborations, and upholds the five root principles of the SFA Way.
- *Each chapter is able to nominate themselves once*

Chapter of the Year

- *Awarded to: One chapter within either PHC, NPHC, MGC or IFC councils*
- Must be a chapter in good standing with the university and Nationals
- Must possess a good academic record
- Must exhibit strong sense of school pride and spirit
- Must be considered a 4 or 5 STAR chapter
- Must provide documentation on exceptional programming, service and philanthropic initiatives
- Must demonstrate involvement and contribution to campus life and/or community activities
- *Each chapter is able to nominate themselves once*
- *Council Presidents will present their own Chapter of the Year award as well*



Overall Excellence in Service

- *Awarded to: One chapter within either PHC, NPHC, MGC or IFC councils*
- Must be a chapter in good standing with the university and Nationals
- Chapter must have conceived, planned and implemented their community service program (not a national program)
- Program must have been beneficial for those intended
- Must have included all members of the chapter
- Specifics of the program must be detailed with proper documentation
- *Max. of 1 nomination per chapter*

Overall Excellence in Philanthropy

- *Awarded to: One chapter within either PHC, NPHC, MGC or IFC councils*
- Must be a chapter in good standing with the university and Nationals
- Chapter must have conceived, planned and implemented their philanthropy project (not a national project)
- Program must have been beneficial for those intended
- Must have included all members of the chapter
- Specifics of the project must be detailed with proper documentation
- *Max. of 1 nomination per chapter*

Outstanding New Member Education

- *Awarded to: One chapter within either PHC, NPHC, MGC or IFC councils*
- Must be a chapter in good standing with the university and Nationals
- Must be a new member program or educational development to be considered
- Must excel in scholastic programming and sisterhood activities
- *Max. of 1 nomination per chapter*

Outstanding Chapter Engagement

- *Awarded to: One chapter within either PHC, NPHC, MGC or IFC councils*
- Must be a chapter in good standing with the university and Nationals
- Must have outside organization involvement from chapter members
- Must be recognized in the SFA Pine Log, Sawdust, The Daily Sentinel, or local TV stations
- Must have documentation of supporting University and Athletic events beyond required
- *Max. of 1 nomination per chapter*

Outstanding Chapter Greek-Greek Collaboration

- *Awarded to: One chapter within either PHC, NPHC, MGC or IFC councils*
- Must be a chapter in good standing with the university and Nationals
- Must show detailed documentation on collaboration with another Greek chapter
- Must be an educational program, community service project, philanthropy partnership, risk management education or new member program collaboration to be considered
- *Max. of 1 nomination per chapter*

Outstanding Chapter Greek- Non-Greek Collaboration

- *Awarded to: One chapter within either PHC, NPHC, MGC or IFC councils*
- Must be a chapter in good standing with the university and Nationals
- Must show detailed documentation on collaboration with a non-Greek organization
- Must be an educational program, community service project, philanthropy partnership, risk management education or new member program collaboration to be considered
- *Max. of 1 nomination per chapter*



Excellence in Overall Chapter Programming

- *Awarded to: One chapter within either PHC, NPHC, MGC or IFC councils*
- Must be a chapter in good standing with the university and Nationals
- Must be either educational, new member, risk management, diversity or leadership development programs
- Must have been presented by chapter leadership, another Greek chapter/council, Greek Life Staff, or SFA faculty/staff
- Co-sponsored events will be considered as long as there is clear evidence of the chapter's involvement in planning the program and presenting the information.
- *Max. of 1 nomination per chapter*

The following awards do not require a nomination; they will be determined by the Greek Life Staff:

Outstanding Greek Life GPA and Outstanding Chapter President (1 chapter per council)
