

- **Parade Details:**

- Parade entries MUST enter parade route on Mimms Ave.
- Parade begins promptly at 10 a.m.
 - *Floats may begin lining up at 8:30 a.m.*
 - *Floats must be in place no later than 9:15 a.m.*

**** All floats must check in with 2011 SFA HOMECOMING PARADE**

MARSHALSBY 9:15 a.m.

- A distance of 30 ft must be maintained between each unit.
- A maximum of 20 people are allowed on each float
- All drivers of floats must be licensed and adequately trained to drive their float.
- FLOAT requirements:
 - Floats may not exceed 20 ft in width and must not be taller than 15 feet.
 - NO 18 WHEELERS WILL BE ALLOWED IN PARADE!!
 - Maximum float length is 55 feet (included vehicle and trailer).
 - A turn radius of 45 degrees to right and left is mandatory.
- NO CANDY, PRIZE THROWING, HANDING OUT BALLOONS is allowed from any parade entry! Patrons may walk beside float and hand out candy to spectators- maintaining a safe distance from floats.
- NO ALCOHOL WILL BE TOLERATED.
- If a generator is used on float a minimum 5 lb. abc fire extinguisher is required.
- If livestock are not diapered or clean-up crew immediately following, entry will not be allowed to participate in parade.

- **Parade Route:**

- West on Hospital Street to East Pecan Street; east on Main Street to Walkers Street.
 - *Walking Groups/Children Floats (pre-approved) return to TJR to get off floats*
 - *ALL OTHER FLOATS proceed to University Drive, then north to William R. Johnson Coliseum parking lot (commuter lot) to disassemble. Floats must be disassembled by 1 p.m. Floats may not be left overnight!*
