Eligibility Requirements

Students must meet the minimum requirements listed below to apply for Who's Who. These requirements will be verified by the Office of Student Affairs Programs.

1. Undergraduate—must have completed a minimum of 60 college hours with a 3.0 GPA or higher.
2. Graduate must have a minimum of 12 hours completed and a 3.2 GPA or higher.
3. Transfer students must have completed a minimum of 12 of the 60 hours at SFA.
4. All must be currently enrolled at SFA.
5. May NOT reapply if you have already been selected for this award from SFA or any other College or University.

Application Instructions

1. Complete this application booklet and sign where indicated. Applications may be returned to the Office of Student Affairs Programs, SFA Box 13021, Nacogdoches, TX 75962, or taken to the Baker Pattillo Student Center, Room 3.302. Unsigned applications will not be accepted. Limit answers to space provided. Any additional documents other than letters of recommendation and pages 3 and 4 of this application will not be viewed by the selection committee.
2. Letters of recommendation from faculty and/or staff are suggested but not required. Letters must be of reproductive quality and received by the deadline of April 8, 2011. Letters may be sent to the Office of Student Affairs Programs, SFA Box 13021, Nacogdoches, TX 75962, taken to the Baker Pattillo Student Center Room 3.302, or be faxed to: (936) 468-1087, letters may also accompany the completed application.
3. **MAKE 6 COPIES OF PAGES 3 AND 4 OF THE COMPLETED APPLICATION AND ANY ACCOMPANYING LETTERS.** Return application and the six copies to the Office of Student Affairs Programs by the deadline. Applications and letters of recommendation will not be returned.

Selection Criteria

The Who's Who award was created to recognize outstanding students on American campuses of higher education. Selection is based on the following criteria: scholarship, participation and leadership in academic and extracurricular activities, citizenship, and service to the university and community. Students are judged only on UNIVERSITY LEVEL accomplishments with more weight given to SFA activities and awards. Participation in civic activities during University enrollment will be weighed as heavily as SFA activities.

Recipients at SFA are selected by a committee composed of faculty, staff, and students. Student committee members are generally previous Who's Who recipients. We hope to announce the recipients by the end of April. All applicants will be notified of the decisions of the Selection Committee.

High school achievements will not be considered.
