Obtain a SFA BS in chemistry or biochemistry degree with 3.0 GPA and be eligible for the Ph.D. bridge program with Morgan State University that allows for easy admission, tuition waiver, and a \$2k monthly stipend depending on availability of funds.
- 8 SFA offers a variety of couses during the summer parts of term in addition to the fall and spring semesters listed above.
- 9 Fall and spring semesters offer courses in a 16-week format, with select courses also available in an 8-week format.
