- 2. No more than 79 hours can be transferred from HCC to SFA.
- 3. Students who have completed the 42-hour core curriculum required at HCC are considered as core complete with SFA.
- 4. Students must pass SFA's readiness assessment review. Review dates are posted at sfasu.edu/hms/103.asp.
- 5. A minimum of 120 total semester hours (transfer + SFA hours) is required to earn this Bachelor of Science in interior design. If you have only completed the 77 HCC hours from this articulation agreement, you will still need to complete the remaining 43 SFA hours as required on this degree guide to have the 120 hours to graduate. You must take a minimum of 120 hours, and at least 30 hours of SFA coursework must be taken at the advanced level (3000-4999).
