- (1) EDUC 1300 is only required for First Time in College (FTIC) students at LSC. If student is not FTIC, please consult Advisor for Elective options. EDUC 1300 contributes three elective credit hours toward the Associate of Arts (AA) degree.
- (2) Course is four hours at LSC and three hours at SFA. Additional hour counts towards elective hours at SFA.
- (3) Major Classes: Student chooses classes required for major. Student must complete the following courses to graduate: BCOM3347, BCOM4347, BCOM4350, BUSI 3330, BUSI3345, and BUSI3350
- (4) Major Elective Option 1 Student chooses 3 hours from BLAW4356, BUSI4300, BUSI4385, or MGMT3373
- (5) Major Elective Option 2 Student chooses 6 hours from the following: BUSI3310, BUSI4340, and BUSI3321

Completion of the AA degree requires a minimum of 15 elective hours. The courses listed are preferred for transfer and program completion at SFASU. Course is not required for completion of AA degree. Course will apply to the BBA at SFASU and maximize the student's transfer hours.
