- (3) Major Classes - Student chooses two classes from two different prefixes (BLAW, BCOM, and BUSI). See advisor for options
- (4) Major Electives - Student chooses 9 hours of courses from the College of Business at a 3000 or 4000 level, with no more than 6 hrs. from the same prefix

Completion of the AA degree requires a minimum of 15 elective hours. The courses listed are preferred for transfer and program completion at SFASU.
