- Major Electives - Student must choose 3 courses from these major elective options: MKTG 3358 (Sports Marketing), MKTG 3326 (Sports Promotion), MGMT 4325 (College Sports Business), BLAW 3355 (Sports and Entertainment Law), or ECON 3359 (Sports Economics).
- A maximum of 66 hours of academic courses plus up to 4 hours of PHED/KINE courses from community colleges can be applied in a bachelor's degree. If a student is Core Complete at LSC, they are Core Complete at SFA – if Core is not complete at LSC, core must be completed using SFA's requirements.
- Note: Students will be required to repeat pre-requisite courses when the grade is below a C. A minimum of 30 semester hours of work must be completed at SFA, of which at least 30 hours must be advanced. Contact your SFA advisor for alternative courses to the core courses listed.
- SFA offers a variety of courses during the summer parts of term in addition to the fall and spring semesters listed above.
- Fall and spring semesters offer courses in a 16-week format, with select courses also available in an 8-week format.
