Total Hours: 66

- 1 If a student is Core Complete at Panola College, they are Core Complete at SFA – if Core is not complete at Panola College, core must be completed using SFA's requirements.
- 2 Students will be required to repeat certain pre-requisite courses when the grade is below a C.
- 3 Must have 30 upper-level hours at SFA and 120 hours total to graduate.
- 4 1 hour of nursing elective must be completed for the degree. Electives are offered fall, spring, and summer.
- 5 Excessive hours: If exceeding 30 hours above 120 (150), will have to pay an additional \$200 per credit hour (does not include dual credit or out of state credit). Is not applicable to second bachelor's degree. See enclosed advising form for current hours listed on mySFA account.
- 6 If accepting financial aid, must have 6 hour each term (Fall, Spring, Summer) to qualify for half-time aid and 12 hours each term (Fall, Spring, Summer) to qualify for full-time aid. If needing an extra hour of elective to meet those hours, let RN-BSN Coordinator know.
