

SFA One Hundred applicants will be ranked based on the percentage of compound annual growth in sales or revenue (net of returns) for the 2023–2025 period, and the top 100 companies will be recognized. To ensure the integrity and credibility of the ranked list, an external, independent accounting firm—Carr, Riggs & Ingram—will confidentially manage all applicant baseline financial data. All submitted financial information will remain strictly confidential with the independent accounting firm and will never be shared with Stephen F. Austin State University, the University of Texas System and its member institutions, their personnel, or any other third party.

- To qualify for consideration, the company must have:
 - been in continuous business for three years or more as of Dec. 31, 2025
 - and had revenues of at least \$200,000 every fiscal year since Jan. 1, 2023
- To qualify for consideration, the company must be one of the following since Jan. 1, 2024:
 - Lumberjack founded: SFA alumni founded the company and holds the position of CEO, chairman, president, managing partner or other C-Suite title.
 - Lumberjack owned: SFA alumni owns a majority (50% or more) of the company.
 - Lumberjack led: SFA alumni holds the position of CEO, chair, president, managing partner or other C-Suite title.
- The company and its Lumberjack founders, owners and leaders act with high integrity and operate in a manner consistent with the values and image of SFA and the Arnold Center for Entrepreneurship. Please see FAQ section on www.sfasu.edu/ace/sfa100
