1. Texas Success Initiative scores, if required, must be on file prior to enrolling in classes. Students who have not completed TSI requirements may be required to register for developmental coursework as appropriate. Contact the Student Success Center at (936) 468-5803 for information about individual testing requirements and how to submit your scores. Visit sfasu.edu/tsi for TSI requirements.

Students who have not submitted their required TSI scores by June 11, 2021, will not be allowed to participate in the Jacks PASS program.

2. Students must select a specific academic college based on their major interest in order to be enrolled in the appropriate courses. Select one college by placing the letter "X" on the line near the college. An advisor within the Student Success Center will select the student's summer schedule. Advisor class selections are final.

If you are unsure about a major at this time and would like to be undeclared, please choose College of Liberal and Applied Arts.

One 1-credit SFAS 1101 course (required)

*One TSI developmental course, INRW 0399, is offered as part of the Jacks PASS program. If you are required to take INRW because you are "Not College Ready" in reading and/or writing, your schedule during Summer will include this course in place of one of the 3-credit core curriculum courses. If you are required to take a developmental math course because you are "Not College Ready" in math, you will be enrolled in the appropriate developmental math course for Fall 2021. Developmental courses do not count for degree credit, and the grade for the course is not calculated into your cumulative SFA GPA. However, your grade in developmental coursework WILL BE calculated in your GPA to determine successful completion of the Jacks PASS program and Fall admission.

4. Successful completion of all Jacks PASS courses, including SFAS 1101 is required to proceed to Fall enrollment. A student who earns a grade of "F" in any course, including INRW 0399 or SFAS 1101, in Summer will not be allowed to continue to Fall 2021. An overall cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher is required for Fall enrollment.
5. All Jacks PASS students are required to attend a Freshman Orientation session during the month of June. For more information regarding registration visit <http://www.sfasu.edu/orientation/first-year>.
6. In addition, all Jacks Pass students are required to attend the Jacks PASS Orientation for onboarding and student success prior to the beginning of the program. Date(s) to be announced.
7. All Jacks PASS students are strongly encouraged to enroll in linked core curriculum course sections for Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 designated as part of the Jacks PASS learning community. More information regarding these courses will be provided by the Jacks PASS Coordinator.
8. Attendance policies will be announced in individual courses. Students are required to abide by attendance policies set by individual instructors.
9. Violations of the Student Code of Conduct will be justification for removal from the Jacks PASS program and/or denial of enrollment for the Fall term. Be aware there is a zero tolerance for all drug and alcohol-related offenses on the SFA campus and these offenses could result in suspension from SFA.
