Science Core: Six hours from: AST 105; BIO 121, 123, 125, 131, 133, 225, 238; CHE 101, 111, 133, 134; ENV 110; GOL 101, 131, 132; PHY 100, 101, 102, 110, 131,132, 241, 242

Creative Arts Core: ART 280, 281, 282; DAN 140; MHL 245; MUS 140; THR 161, 163

Math Core Three hours from: MTH 110, 138, 143, 220 and 233; College math core requires math course MTH133 or above

Humanities core Three hours from: ENG 200 – 233H; HIS 151, 152, 161, 162; PHI 153, 223;

College Science Core: has to be two courses from the same line: 1) ANT248, ANT251, or GEO130; 2) BIO131, 133, 225, 238, or 239; 3) CHE133, 134, 231; 4) ENV110, GOL131 or GOL132; 5) AST105, PHY110, 131, 132, 241, or 242.
