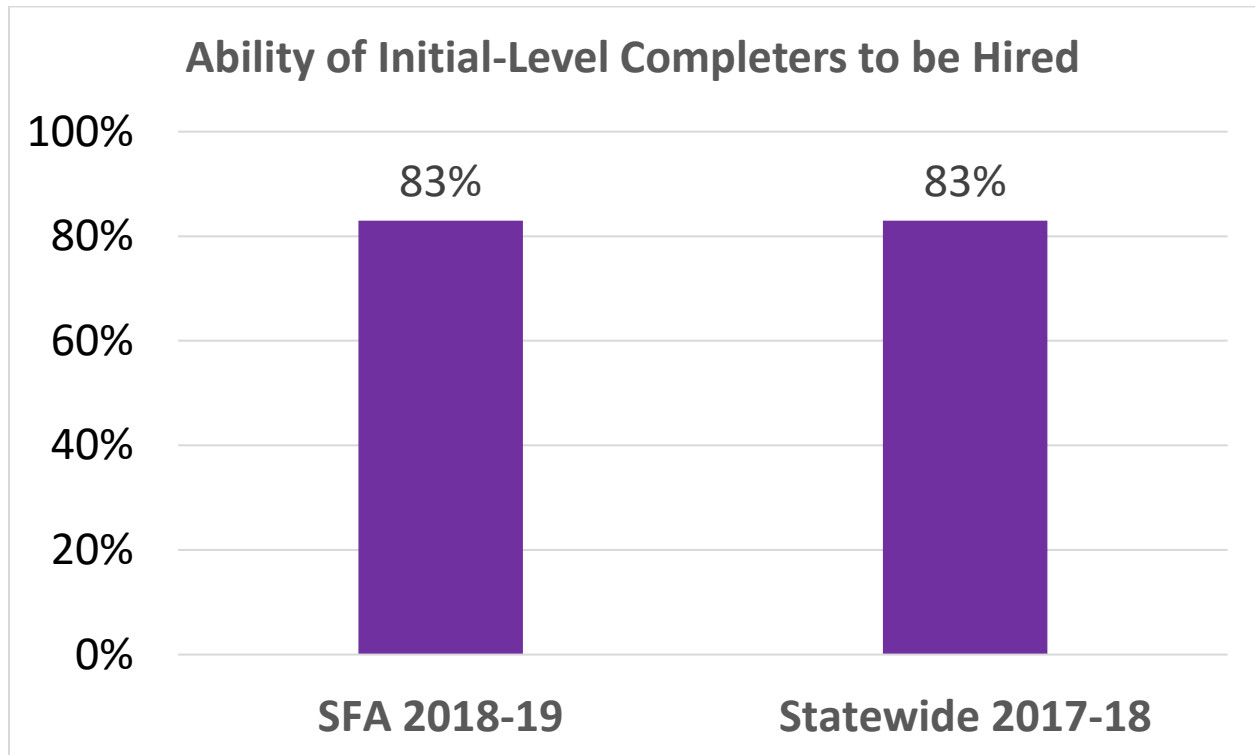

**A.5.4 Ability of completers to be hired in education positions for which they have been prepared:**

Using the latest data available from the Texas Education Agency, it was determined there were 218 SFA program finishers who were certified in advanced programs areas in 2017-18. Approximately 15% of SFA prepared educators in advanced programs found jobs in their advanced field of certification in the first year after completion. The largest advanced educator preparation program offered at SFA is Principal Certification. Most of those who complete this program continue in their roles as classroom teacher for more than one year before a Principal position is open and/or deciding to take such a position, thus providing context and rationale for the 15%. If the Principal group is removed, the percentage is 45.
