 - Purple Promise \$ for college Details about requirements and at the link below.
 - What is the Purple Promise Guarantee Program?
 - The Purple Promise Guarantee Program pays the *remaining balance for a flat rate tuition and regular fees **that are not covered** by other grants, scholarships, exemptions, benefits or waivers.
 - Purple Promise will only cover up to four years toward your undergraduate degree, and only as long as you remain eligible each year.
 - It's important to note that the program does not:
 - cover tuition and fees for summer semesters.
 - automatically renew each year unless the student remains eligible.
 - Eligibility requirements:

- Be enrolling or have initially enrolled at SFA as a full-time, first-time, first-year student for the summer or fall term.
- Be a Texas resident
- Be a "dependent student" as defined by FAFSA
- Have a combined family adjusted gross income of \$80,000 or less, based on the information you enter on your FAFSA
- Complete all <u>financial aid application</u> <u>requirements</u> by June 1 *+extended to July 1, 2024, including:
 - admission to SFA as a regular degree-seeking student
 - financial aid office receiving your valid FAFSA
- Dr. Judy Abbott, Dean
 - UT system board of regents will meet with 4 SFA presidential candidates. A decision is expected to be made by Friday February 23rd, 2024.
- Educator Preparation and PCOE updates: EDD in Ed Leadership joined Carnegie Project on the Education Doctorate. The Masters degree program in Educational Leadership joined the Wallace Foundation Quality Matters group. The BSIS and other ed prep degrees are working on the grant from the Houston Endowment Foundation.
- o Dr. Jannah Nerren, Ed Studies Dept. Chair
 - Yearlong Residency updates- Partnered with three districts, 24 students have applied for the 1st cohort. Spring 25-No new cohort. Fall 25 we will add more districts and the 2nd cohort begins.
 - Education Studies-
 - Our Teacher Preparation Inspection visit is coming up and we are getting ready. This allows from program review and feedback from a third party.
 - Grown your own applications with Tomball and Spring ISD are due March 5th.
 - Reading academies: As requested we began recruiting for the reading academies. Ronda McClain wrote the application to TEA. Participation has been very low. As you know these students are very busy. We will skip year 2 application but plan to reup in year 3.

 - Dr. Cross gave grant updates
 - o Ed Studies is always looking for qualified high-quality faculty who might be interested in teaching one course with us.
