

CAEP Oversight Committee

The purpose of the College CAEP Oversight Committee is to steer, oversee, and maintain the PCOE Educator Preparation Programs to the Council for Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) standards.

1. Committee Composition
 - a. 2 members from each department/school representing undergraduate and graduate programs selected by chair in consultation with Associate Dean of Assessment and Accountability
 - b. 1 or more representatives from each college selected by deans in consultation with Associate Dean of Assessment and Accountability
 - c. Associate Dean of Student Affairs
 - d. Associate Dean of Assessment and Accountability (Chair)

2. Committee Responsibilities
 - a. Review CAEP standards, crosswalk with current system of meeting NCATE standards and conduct a gap-analysis
 - b. Participate in evaluation of the current assessment system and make recommendations to steer modification of the system to meet CAEP standards
 - d. Make other recommendations for the transition from NCATE standards to CAEP standards
 - f. Other responsibilities as arise

3. Reporting Structure
 - a. The CAEP Oversight Committee is standing James I. Perkins College of Education committee. Representatives are appointed for 2 year terms and serve on a rotation basis ensuring that there are always members with experience on the committee.
 - b. The committee reports to the Dean of the College.
 - c. The work of the CAEP Oversight Committee is supported and facilitated by the Office of Assessment & Accountability.
