TEA Updates & Information During COVID-19



Certification Information

As a Result of Governor's Waivers due to COVID-19

- In the 2020-2021 school year, there are approximately 14,000 teachers who had not completed testing requirements prior to the issuance of their certification
 - One-year Waiver Probationary Certificates issued to EPP finishers who were unable to complete testing requirements
 - **7,312** certificates issued to **5,918** Individuals
 - SFASU recommended 95
 - Intern Waiver Certificates issued to candidates enrolled in an EPP who were unable to complete testing requirements
 - **11,470** certificates issued to **8,118** Individuals
 - SFASU recommended 1

Certification Information

(As a Result of Governor's Waivers due to COVID-19)

- First year teachers (completing requirements in 19-20)
 were issued certification based on the following:
 - Spring 2020 as few as 35 days of clinical teaching
 - TEA requires 70 SFA requires 75
- First year teachers (completing requirements in 20-21)
 will be issued certification based on the following:
 - Fall 2020 as few as 30 hours of observations prior to clinical teaching and as few as 56 days of clinical teaching
 - TEA is allowing all observations to be electronic/video
 - Some candidates have only had virtual experiences with clinical teaching
- TEA-sponsored program to offer support to all educators and education students

SFA Clinical Teachers as Educational Aides

- Number of educational aides who completed clinical teaching through their education educational aide duties:
 - Spring 2020 24
 - Fall 2020 35
 - Spring 2021 30 as of 10/20/2020
- Encourage your educational aides/paraprofessionals to enroll in one of our online certification programs!
 - Core Subjects EC-6
 - All Areas of Middle Level Grades (4-8)
 - Special Education



Science of Teaching Reading

- Legislature mandates that all teachers pursuing a certification that includes grades prekindergarten through grade 6 demonstrate proficiency in the science of teaching reading.
- December 31, 2020
 - Last date for candidates to receive their certification in the following areas without needing the Science of Teaching Reading (STR) exam
 - Core Subjects: Early Childhood Grades 6
 - Core Subjects: Grades 4-8
 - English Language Arts and Reading: Grades 4-8
 - ELAR/SST: Grades 4-8



Pearson's Steps To Address Testing Challenges

- Pearson owned testing centers have reopened
- Addition of new partner centers
- Extension of hours/days of operations at centers
 - Social distancing requirements are factored into capacity
