These indicators are described in Texas Education Code (TEC) §21.045 and enacted in rule in Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 229. TEC statute identifies five measures, which TAC rule further delineates into seven separate indicators:

- 1a: Certification examination results for pedagogy tests
- 1b: Certification examination results for content pedagogy tests
- 2: Principal appraisal of the preparation of first-year teachers
- 3: Improvement in student achievement of students taught by beginning teachers
- 4a: Frequency and duration of field observations
- 4b: Quality of field supervision
- 5: Satisfaction of new teachers
