2021-2022 Accreditation Status Accredited – Warned Status Defined

- 1. (i) An EPP shall be assigned Accredited-Warned status if the EPP:
 - 1. (I) fails to meet the performance standards set by the SBEC for the overall performance of all its candidates on any of the indicators set forth in subsection (a) of this section in any one year;
 - 2. (II) fails to meet the performance standards in two demographic groups on an indicator set forth in subsection (a) of this section in any one year; or
 - 3. (III) fails to meet the performance standards for a demographic group on any of the indicators set forth in subsection (a) of this section for two consecutively measured years, regardless of whether the deficiency is in the same demographic group or standard.
- 2. (ii) An EPP may be assigned Accredited-Warned status if the SBEC determines that the EPP has violated SBEC rules, orders, and/or TEC, Chapter 21.







