

TEA GROW YOUR OWN GRANT: PATHWAY 3

- YEAR-LONG CLINICAL TEACHING ASSIGNMENT (SUBMITTED BY IHES)
- GRANTS AWARDED AT \$22,000 PER PARTICIPATING TEACHER CANDIDATE MAXIMUM OF 10 TCS/IHE
- MAY PARTNER WITH UP TO 5 LEAS WITH 2 TEACHER
 CANDIDATES PARTICIPATING AT EACH LEA
- MOU –TC AGREES TO RETURN TO THE LEA FOR AN AGREED UPON LENGTH OF TIME AS A FULL-TIME TEACHER

EPP ADMISSION CRITERIA CHANGES

- 12-HOURS AT SFA WILL ---NO LONGER REQUIRED
- 60-HOURS NO LONGER REQUIRED
