



Minimum Course Enrollments

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish minimum course enrollments for undergraduate and graduate courses and to outline the process for requesting exceptions to this policy.

Persons Affected

Faculty and Students.

Policy

SFA HOP 02-215 Minimum Course Enrollments establishes the minimum enrollment of undergraduate courses to be ten (10) students and graduate/doctoral courses to be five (5) students.

The College of Sciences and Mathematics further requires that all 1000- and 2000-level lecture and lab courses enroll a minimum of fifteen (15) students.

All exceptions to SFA HOP 02-215 and to the college's requirements must be approved by the dean and the provost as set forth in SFA HOP 02-215 Minimum Course Enrollments.
