Participants will explore what the 5 tools do, how they function, and practical strategies for using them to streamline course management, foster collaboration, and create more engaging and interactive learning experiences. The session will provide concrete examples and hands-on practice to help faculty integrate M365 into their teaching to support student success.

Qualtrics 2025

Building surveys and quizzes in Qualtrics has never been easier. Join Theunis as he walks through setting up a Qualtrics account, creating and launching a Qualtrics survey, and analyzing and visualizing the data. This session is useful for faculty, staff, and graduate students using Qualtrics for in-class research projects.

Teaching Tips – Building Community in Online Courses

This session explores practical teaching techniques and tips, including quick and effective strategies to encourage student participation and cultivate a community of engaged learning. Participants will learn about assignment design and group work, building community, and more.

Teaching with Intention
