
# Interactive Texts for Active Learning

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### Instructor Concerns Re: Assigned Reading

- Sound familiar? →
- How do I know *if* my students read or *what* they understood?
- How do I get the most out of class discussion, not knowing what my students do or do not already know?



### Wouldn't it be great to...

- Reveal more about the text to improve my students' reading experience?
- Quickly assess what they understood to open up more time for discussion?
- Increase student responsibility and engagement?



### "Actively Learn" in Overview

- Online digital literacy platform
- Main feature: creating interactive texts
  - Start with a reading
  - Add infographics, pictures, links, comments
  - Embed gradable questions (automated or manual)



### "Actively Learn" in Overview


- Ideal for:
  - Online and hybrid courses
  - Any course with a focus on critical reading
- Free version for instructors and students
  - Limitation: 3 text imports a month
  - (But if you build your course ahead of time...)

### Examples

4<sup>th</sup> semester Spanish - students watch a film. I want them to engage with the dialog. But how?

Quiz on Actively Learn. They read script excerpts, with my notes on the side.


This is the "Ave María" - a very important prayer in the Catholic church.

- They answer the questions and I transfer their score to d2L
