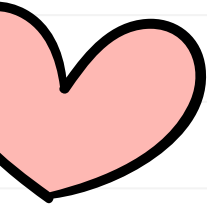

# SYNCHRONOUS + ASYNCHRONOUS OPTIONS

## ZOOM CIRCLES

Occur during a class period in a **synchronous** setting. Teacher facilitates interactions and guides the discussion.

## VIRTUAL BOOK CLUBS

Occur **asynchronously** and provide a space for community & relationship building amongst students. Teacher views recorded meetings and provides suggestions and clarifications in feedback.

I am going to bounce around in the video, so if I missed something that you wanted me to address, please just let me know.

I noticed that y'all struggled with the text... that it was a snooze for a few of you and that it took too long to make the point for others. I hope it gets better... I think it's a great text.

I also noticed that you all THOUGHT struggled with the "high impact quotes" -- but you did!!! It's just something that resonated with you or something you connected to!

Great points about what we will be teaching later!!! How will the coronavirus be covered?

One source to improve would be that I noticed a lot of cutting each other off. It's due to excitement so I'm not mad... but it's gonna throw your students off if they feel they can't finish their thoughts. What will you do to create a more "respectful" space? Or to monitor time?
