


WHAT

Short videos
 (5-15 minutes)
 demonstrating
 and/or explaining
 the solution to a
 practice exercise.




WHERE

- After exposition of content but before graded assignments.
- Bridging theory and application.
- Online Courses: after readings, but before discussion boards and written assignments.
- Face-to-Face Courses: could be used for supplements and/or review.



WHY

- More efficient than prose for visually-driven analysis.
- Reinforces the most difficult stage in the learning process.
- Manageable due to limited scope.
- Reusable.



HOW

- Create and digitize the solution
- Main recording: visual and audio via screen capture
 - Ex.: QuickTime
- Additional audio (if needed)
 - Ex. Tascam recorder or microphone
- Polish in Video Editing Software (if needed/desired)
 - Ex.: Premiere Pro from Adobe Suite
 - Tasks: cut extra material, integrate secondary audio, add cover page.
- Upload to hosting service (ex.: YouTube) and add to Brightspace Module.
