- The minutes of the September meeting of the Senate were read, corrected, and approved.
- 2. In accordance with the constitution, a lottery was held to decide the tenure of senators (one, two, or three year terms). Mr. Ericson observed that former members of the Faculty Advisory Council now serving in the Senate should be awarded one year terms. The Senate accepted this suggestion. See Appendix A for the results of the lottery.
- 3. The Secretary read the letter of Paul Woods declining election to the Senate due to his leave of absence. Mr. Walter Robertson (Biology) was declared elected to fill the vacant position.
- 4. Messrs. Brophy and Franks reported on the question of library representation on the Faculty Senate. They recommended that the faculty be asked to approve amending the Constitution so that Section 4, the first sentence of the second paragraph should read: "The total number of faculty representatives shall be twenty-six, one of whom will be a professional librarian elected by professional librarians." Mr. Brophy put this recommendation into the form of a motion. It was seconded and approved by voice vote of the Senate.

- 5. Messrs, Hill and Hamrick reported on the 1971 summer schedule. They recommended that the summer term calendar be changed so that Saturday classes be eliminated. In the proposed calendar, the First Summer Term would begin with advising and registration on May 31. Classes would begin on June 1, and final exams would fall on July 7. The Second Summer Term would begin with registration on July 8, classes beginning the next day, commencement on August 12, and final exams would be held on August 13. (See Appendix 3.) Classes would begin at 7:30 a.m. both sessions and would run one hour and forty minutes. The recommendation was put into the form of a notion by Mr. Hamrick. It was seconded and approved by the Senate.
- The Chairman reported that the student leaders with whom he had talked had not yet finished the form to be used for the proposed classroom teacher evaluation project.
- 7. The Chairman raised the question of the position of the Faculty Senate in the organizational chart of the University. After a discussion of some of the problems in locating the Faculty Senate in the proper position, Mr. Ercison moved that the question be tabled. The motion was seconded and passed.

The Chair appointed Messrs. Ericson, Yarbrough, and Collier to study the problem and draw up an organizational chart which would include a location for the Faculty Senate.

The Senate was adjourned.
