President Steen appeared before a meeting of the Faculty Senate at which members of the student congress also attended. Representatives of the architectural consulting firm employed by the University presented the proposed master building plan for the next ten years of the University's growth. The firm's representative, Dr. Steen, and other members of the University's administration answered questions from the members of the Senate. Dr. Steen concluded by asking for the opinion of the members of the Senate of the proposed building program. The response of the Senate members was that they were generally in favor of the proposed building program.
