- 1. Mr. McDonald called the meeting to order, the roll was called, and the minutes of Meeting No. 21 were approved with the following correction:

- 2. Mr. Hill reported that the Senate Committee on Student Affairs had received statements from the Schools of Fine Arts, Science & Mathematics and Education concerning their policy on major examinations during the last week of classes. Mr. Baker reported that the School of Forestry's policy would be sent to Mr. Hill.
- 3. Mr. McDonald announced the report of the nominating committee for Senate officers for 1972-73. He then proceeded to the election of officers.
  - A. Mr. Yarbrough had been nominated for Chairman. From the floor Mr. Richman nominated Mr. Nall; Mr. Bourbon seconded the nomination, By secret ballot, Mr. Nall was elected Chairman.

B. Mr. Gaston was elected Vice-Chairman and Mr. Baker was elected Secretary, there being no nominations from the floor.
