1. Chairman Ford called the meeting to order at 3:15 p.m.
  2. Minutes of Meeting No. 66 were approved as written.
  3. Dr. Ford recognized the retiring Senators and expressed her appreciation for their diligent work in making this a good year.
  4. Dr. Ford speaking for the Faculty Senate extended congratulations to the Department of Home Economics upon being accredited by the American Home Economic Association.
  5. The treasurer, Mr. Jesse Richardson, reported that \$814.58 remains in the allocated budget.
  6. Dr. Gloria Durr, Chairman of the Academic Affairs Committee, presented the following recommendations concerning interdisciplinary programs:
    - A. That school councils explore ways of initiating interdepartmental programs within the school.
    - B. Persons involved in programs requiring interschool efforts should solicit dialogue between interschool disciplines.
    - C. New programs should be examined by school councils and university administration in light of possibilities for interdisciplinary cooperation.

7. Dr. Fred Rainwater speaking for the professional Welfare Committee, reported concerning inequities in teaching loads. This matter was referred to the new senate for further study.
  8. Dr. Ford enumerated the items and/or issues for further study by the Senate for 1976-77:
    - A. Change from department heads to departmental chairmen.
    - B. Question of limited terms of office for deans and heads.

- C. Report of the ad hoc committee studying the Fiscal Affairs Division of the University.
- D. A resolution to honor outstanding active faculty members for years of service.
- 9. The Executive Committee of the Faculty Senate submitted recommendations for the University Committees for 1976-77.
- 10. Dr. Deanne Malpass distributed copies of a letter received from Dr. Roy E. Cain concerning the report submitted by the ad hoc committee studying the Fiscal Affairs Division of the University. The letter was referred to committee for study by the new Senate 1976-77.
- 11. The next meeting will be the first Wednesday, May 5, 1976 in the Aztec Room at 3:15 p.m.
- 12. The meeting adjourned at 3:35 p.m.
